ABSTRACT: The abstract should not exceed 300 words and must be accompanied by a cover page stating the following:-

- Name of the author(s)

FULL RESEARCH PAPER:

- The paper should not exceed 4000 words (exclusive of footnotes)
- Co-authorship is permitted with a maximum of two authors only.
- In case of co-authorship at least one author must attend the seminar to present the paper.
- In case a student is presenting the paper of the faculty members shall be allowed only if they have co-authored the paper.
- The main text should be in Times New Roman with font size 12 and spacing of 1.5.
- The footnotes should be in Times New Roman, font size 10 with single spacing.
- One inch margins on all sides should be maintained.
- **Citation style:** Blue Book.
- The paper must be accompanied with the scanned copies of the filled in Registration form, DD details, cover page, the details of which are mentioned in the abstract guidelines.
- All submissions must be the author’s original and unpublished work. Plagiarized submissions will be disqualified.
