General Instructions

All papers must be original material, not published or presented any time before.

Since the selection of the final papers will be based on the abstracts only, the abstracts must be specific and reflect the intended contents of the paper.

Co-Authorship up to TWO persons is permitted.

Only one abstract can be submitted by a participant based on any of the sub-themes given above.

Guidelines for Submission of Abstract

All abstracts must be in English. The abstract may be prepared using font style TIMES NEW ROMAN in following format.

Title of paper: The abstract title to be in CAPITAL LETTERS only (Font Size 14)

Author(s): Presenting Author's name should be underlined (Font Size 12)

Abstract: The abstract should be of a maximum of 300 words. It should be typed in font size 12 and Single spaced. Paragraphs should be separated by a blank line and should NOT be indented.
