**Three Day Non-Residential Certificate Course in Arbitration**

**06<sup>th</sup> – 08<sup>th</sup> February 2015**

Arbitration has much scope in resolving outstanding disputes legally and formally, as it is a legal, formal, private binding process through which disputes can be resolved by an award made by an independent Arbitral or Panel, which gets constituted after consultations, and with total agreement of both the disputing parties. For a country like India, with its burgeoning cases waiting to be disposed and limited judicial reach, arbitration can be valuable.

**Objective**

The objective of this course is to equip the participants with the knowledge, scope and reach of Arbitration law and practice. The course will study the legal principles applicable to the widely accepted use of arbitration as a means of resolving disputes arising under public and private sector collective.

The course will cover all forms of Arbitration, including Government Arbitration, Commercial Arbitration, Investment and non-commercial arbitration. Participants will be treated to drafting arbitration clauses in Contracts, Appointment of arbitration, Ad hoc arbitration and Institutional arbitration, Venue and seat of arbitration, procedure of arbitration, award of arbitration, Judicial review towards arbitral awards and the scope of foreign arbitration. Apart from the comprehensive theoretical aspects, this course will also cover practical and procedural aspects of the arbitration process with case studies and mock arbitration proceedings.

**Who should attend?**

The Course is designed for professionals, scholars, teachers and practitioners who are familiar with legal reasoning and concepts of Alternative dispute resolution. Those interested in gaining knowledge, skill and expertise in arbitration must attend.

This course has two distinct but related goals. First, it is an in-depth study of the law governing Arbitration in India. Second, it is designed to teach the skills necessary for practitioners in the practice of arbitration. In that respect, it is like a skills-training course.

**Day 1:** Introduction to Arbitration, History, background of the Arbitration law in India scope and limitation and treatment in other legal systems

Drafting Arbitration clauses in Contracts, Arbitration agreements Appointment process

Arbitration and Government: Various forms and procedures.

**Day 2:** terms of reference, Arbitral award, Venue and seat of a arbitration, choice of law, jurisdiction, conflict of interest, pre hearing process, dealing with factual, opinion and documentary evidences.

**Day 3:** Role of National Courts, Cost and remedies, Confidentiality, international arbitration treaties, enforcement of foreign arbitral award and the arbitral rules of leading international arbitration institutions, Investment arbitration
