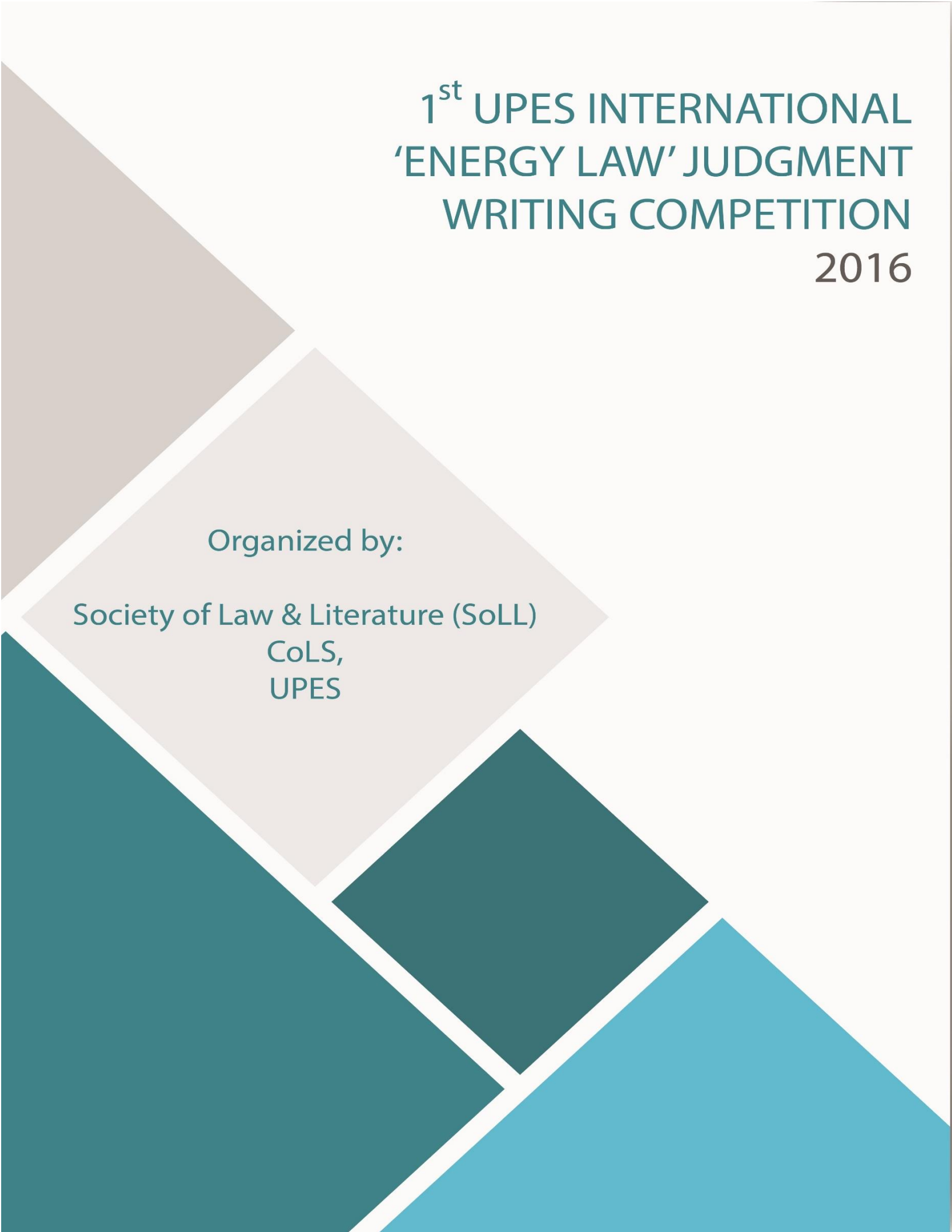




1st UPES INTERNATIONAL 'ENERGY LAW' JUDGMENT WRITING COMPETITION 2016

The Society of Law and Literature (SoLL), CoLS is organizing the 1st UPES International Energy Law Judgement Writing Competition, 2016 based on the 6th Dr. Paras Diwan Memorial International 'Energy Law' Moot Court Competition, 2016.

Cash Prizes to be won worth INR 45,000 along with Certificates of Merit and Participation!

- Winner: INR 20,000/-
- Runner up: INR 10,000/-
- 10 Consolation Prizes: INR 1,500/- each

Eligibility:

Competition is open to ALL.

Any law student as well as law professionals like practising lawyers, judges, faculty can participate. However faculty/staff and students of UPES will be eligible only for consolation prizes.

No. of Authors allowed for each submission: One.

Submission Guidelines

1. The author has to register himself/herself electronically by sending an email at sollcolsupes@gmail.com. The email should contain:
 - Author's Name
 - Course Name/ Profession
 - University
 - Contact No.
 - Address
 - Email account
 - Registration fee submission details (attach a scanned copy of the Bank Receipt/ Transaction ID)
2. The participants will be provided a Unique ID after the completion of the registration process.
3. The final submission should only bear this Unique ID on the top right corner of each page. Author's identification mark must not be found in any part of the judgment.
4. The judgment must be written in English.
5. For the format of the judgment, participants may take help from the previous ICJ judgments available on the ICJ website - www.icj.cjj.org
6. The Cover page of the judgment should contain all the details as provided in an International Court of Justice Judgment.

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7. Participant may confine his/her judgment to the issues raised in the Moot Problem. Participants are not required to give a detailed factual analysis but concentrate on addressing the issues raised.
 8. Judgments to be submitted in .doc/.docx format only with 12 pt font size and 2.0 line spacing on Times New Roman Font.
 9. Judgment should be not more than 3000-5000 words.
 10. Email the submission to sollcolsupes@gmail.com by 15th June, 2016.
 11. The name of the winner will be displayed on UPES website. Seperate intimation will also be sent to each of the winners. The winner will be given the prizes on the prize distribution function to be held at Dehradun, India.
 12. Certificate of participation will be awarded to all participants.
