TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

The following rules shall govern the tournament:

The tournament is open to students pursuing five year integrated LLB Course only. Each institution is permitted to send only one team. Each team shall consist of 15 players accompanied by a team manager.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

1. Teams interested to participate in the tournament shall send an e-mail before **20th February, 2017**, expressing their interest to participate. The email shall be sent to **bilscup2017@gmail.com**.
2. The organizers shall confirm the participation of the team through e-mail by **21st February, 2017**. The registration forms shall also be mailed to the participants.
3. Registration shall be done on first-come-first-serve basis.
4. The registration fee per team shall be **Rs. 3,500/-**. The details of the payment shall be sent to the participating teams after confirmation of their participation. The registration fee paid shall not be refunded at any circumstance whatsoever.
5. The scanned copies of the acknowledgment of payment and the duly filled registration forms shall be mailed to **bilscup2017@gmail.com** as soon as the payment is made. The hard copies of the same shall be sent to the following address on or before **2nd March, 2017**:

OTHER RULES:

1. The tournament shall consist of 16 teams and all the matches shall be knock-out matches.
2. Ties shall be announced after the inaugural function. No changes shall be entertained.
3. Valid college ID Card of each player shall be produced by the teams at the time of reporting.
4. All teams are required to bring along their cricket kit. KSCA approved red balls will be used and provided for the matches.

6. Smoking, alcohol, gutka and tobacco are strictly prohibited in the ground. Late entry to the the day of the match will not be entertained. Use of mobile phones during the duration of the match is prohibited.
7. Accommodation, food and travel facilities will be provided only for out-station teams (players and team manager). No outsiders shall be allowed.
8. Food will be provided for teams from Bengaluru only on match days.
9. Basic medical assistance will be provided. However, if by any chance a sportsman is injured, the organizers are not responsible for any such mishap and the medical expenditure for such injuries shall not be borne by the organizers.
10. Out station teams must report to the organizers **before 6PM on 14th March, 2017**.
11. All teams must attend the inaugural and valedictory functions. Teams failing to do so shall be disqualified and shall not be awarded participation certificates.
12. Any disputes, complaints and grievances during the course of the tournament shall be entertained by the **Redressal Committee** and the decision of the committee in such matters shall be final.

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Team Awards:

1. Winners.
2. 1st Runners-Up.
3. 2nd Runners-Up.

The Winners shall also be awarded a rolling trophy.

Individual Awards:

1. Highest run scorer in the tournament.
2. Highest wicket taker in the tournament.
3. Best catch in the tournament.

All participants shall receive participation certificates.

RULES OF THE GAME

Number of Overs:

- * The tournament shall be of Twenty-20 format played with KSCA-approved red leather balls.

Fielding Restrictions:

- * There shall not be more than 5 fieldsmen on the leg side.
- * For the first 6 overs of each innings, only two fielders are permitted to be outside the thirty-yard circle.
- * For the remaining overs of each innings, only five fielders are permitted to be outside the thirty-yard circle.

Number of Overs per bowler:

- * All matches including the final will be on 20/20 basis. A minimum of 5 bowlers shall be used, subject to maximum of 4 overs per bowler.

Attire:

- * The captains are required to ensure that all the players in their respective teams are in whites for the matches.

Laws:

- * **No Ball:** The front foot overstepping no ball penalty will be one run and an extra ball shall be bowled in the over. The preceding delivery will be a "free hit" wherein the batsmen cannot be dismissed except by being run out. The fielding captain is not allowed to change the position of his fielders except for the case that the batsmen have crossed during the front foot overstepping no ball delivery.
- * **Wide Ball:** The wide ball penalty will be one run and an extra ball shall be bowled in the over.
- * **Timed Out:** The incoming batsman must be in position to receive the next ball within 60 seconds of the fall of the previous wicket.
- * **Time Wasting Penalties:** If the umpire considers the batsman to be un-necessarily wasting time, one warning will be given in an innings. The second time that the umpire deems a batsman wasting time, and for every subsequent instance thereafter, 6 runs shall be added to the total of the fielding side.
- * **Over rate:** The team fielding will have to bowl 20 overs in 90 minutes after which a 10-minute mid-innings break will follow. In case the team does not complete the overs in the allotted time, penalty runs at the rate of 6 runs per over bowled short will be awarded to the batting team.
- * If a team fails to report on time, a walkover will be awarded to the opponent team (subject to the discretion of the organizers).
- * **Playing 11** will have to be chosen from a list of 15 players submitted along with the entry form and no changes in the squad of 15 members will be entertained later.
- * In case of a tie or abandonment of a match due to rain or any other reason, the result of the match will be arrived at by a BOWL OUT. At the end of a tied or abandoned match and before the Bowl Out, each team nominates 5 bowlers. The procedure is similar to a penalty shootout in football. The 5 bowlers from

each side deliver one ball at an unguarded wicket (three stumps). After all the 5 bowlers of each team has bowled, the team which strikes the wicket maximum number of times, wins the match. If each team has hit the same number of wickets after the first 5 bowlers per side, the bowling continues and is decided by sudden death.

- * If a match except finals is abandoned without a ball being bowled, the winners will be declared as per the details given above.
- * A match will be considered abandoned if either side has not batted for a minimum of 6 overs. The winners will be declared on the basis of "BOWL OUT".
- * If no play is possible (including a bowl out), the winner will be decided on the basis of "toss of coin" in the knockout stages.
- * The standard 20/20 international rules will apply under all circumstances.
- * In an emergency, the organizing committee reserves the right to take decision without consulting the teams. No protest in this regard will be entertained.
- * Umpires' decision is final. No complaints will be entertained on this.
