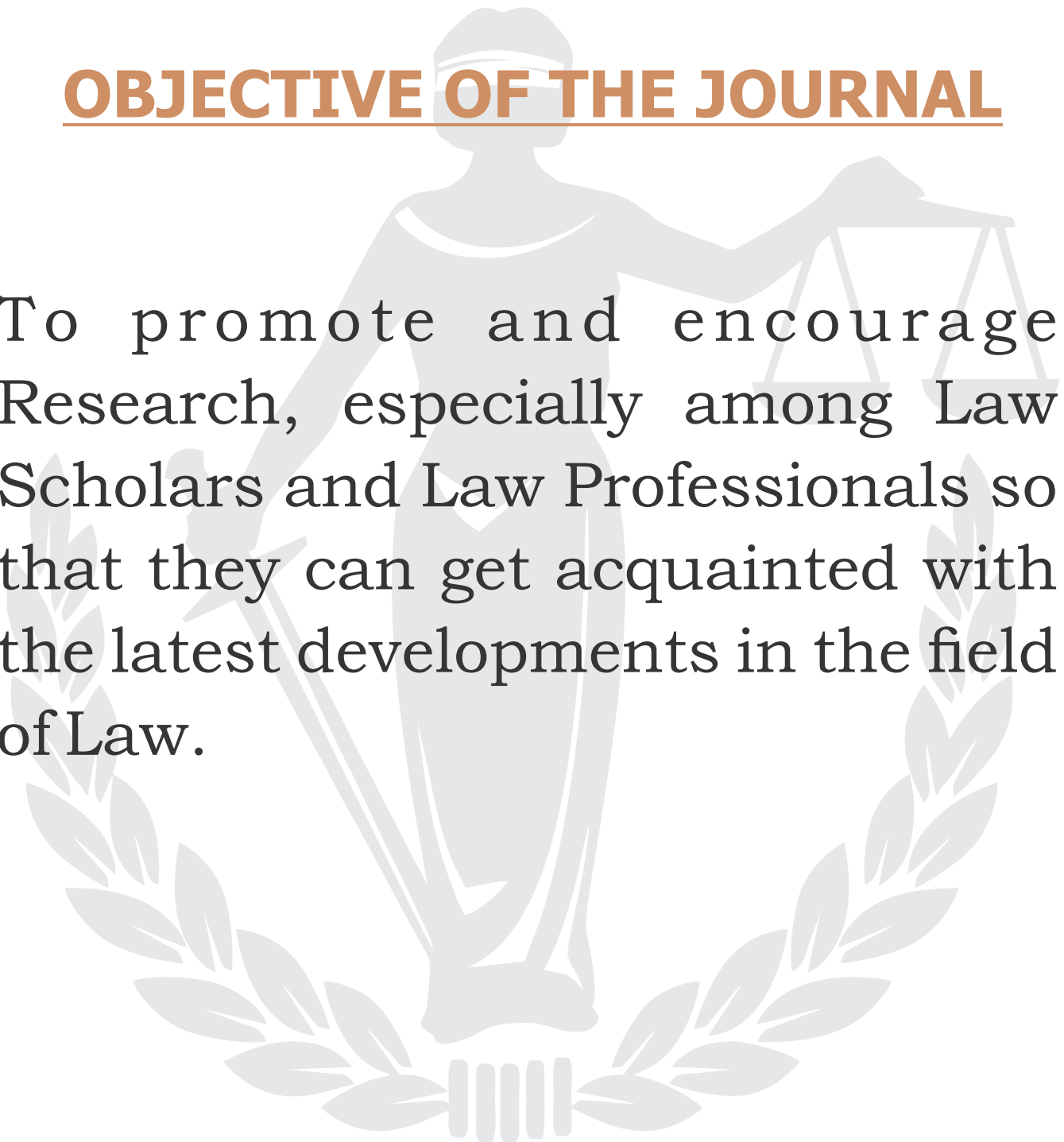

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. WORD LIMIT:

Articles: 4000-5000 words

Case Comments: 2000-3000 words

Book Review: 1500- 2500 words

2. **ABSTRACT:** The full length articles/papers must accompany an abstract not exceeding 300 words and should be accompanied by a cover page stating the following details:

- a) Title of the Paper
- b) Name of the Author(s)
- c) Designation and Institution
- d) E-mail Address
- e) Postal Address
- f) Contact Number
- g) Short-Bio

3. AUTHORSHIP:

Academician, Practitioners, Researchers, Students and Other stakeholders in field of Law are eligible to send in entries. Entries can be co-authored. However, a maximum of two authors per entry is allowed.



4. CITATION STYLE: Standard Indian Legal Citation should be adhered to.

5. FORMAT OF MAIN TEXT & THE FOOTNOTES: The Times New Roman font, in font size 12 is prescribed for all entries. Further, the footnotes shall be in font size 10 and in the Times New Roman font. A line spacing of 1.5 for the main text and 1.0 for footnotes should be followed. All submissions should be in doc or docx format, submissions in pdf shall not be accepted.

Last date for intimation of acceptance of articles: **December 30, 2017.**
