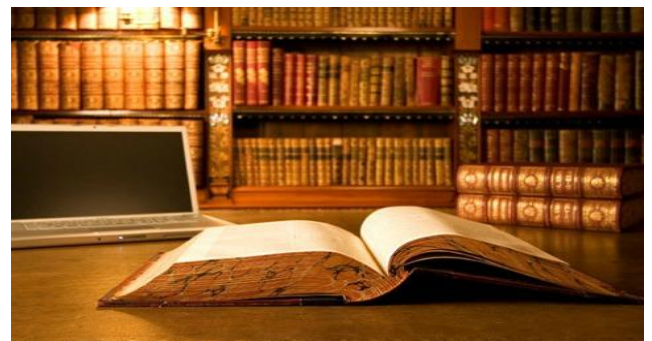
ABOUT CONFERENCE:

SUBMISSIONS GUIDELINES:

- Joint authorship is permitted to a maximum of two authors. However, both authors need to register separately. At least one author must attend the conference to present the paper.
- Submissions are to be made in electronic form only and are to be sent to ilnu.conference@nirmauni.ac.in
- A cover letter mentioning the Name of the Author(s), Professional Position/ Course/Year of Study (as applicable), Name of the Institution/College/University, Postal Address, Email Address and Contact Number must be submitted with the paper as well.
- The full paper must not exceed a maximum of 5000 words (excluding footnotes/endnotes/annexure/reports etc.). The main text should be in Times New Roman with font size 12 and line spacing of 1.5.
- The footnotes should be in Times New Roman, font size 10 with spacing of 1.0.
- One inch margins should be maintained on all four sides.
- Citation Style: Bluebook, 19th Edition.
- Full paper has to be submitted in soft copy in PDF and MS Word.
- Maximum two (02) authors are permitted in one paper. However, both authors are required to pay the individual registration fee.

CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS:

All submitted conference papers will be blind peer reviewed by review committee. The proceedings of National Conference are going to be published.

CERTIFICATES AND REWARDS:

All the participants shall be issued Participation Certificates. Top five Paper will be awarded and selected papers will be published in an edited book with ISSN/ISBN number by the reputed publisher.
