Student’s Code of Conduct

National Law Quiz Competition (Written) based on MCQ will start sharp at 10 A.M & no student will be allowed to enter the seminar hall after 10:30 A.M.

During Competition use of mobile phones, laptops or any other electronic gadget is prohibited for the participants in the Seminar hall.

All participants are expected to maintain the decorum throughout the competition and are expected to conduct themselves in a manner befitting the legal profession.

The organizers reserve the right to take appropriate action for any unethical, unprofessional and immoral conduct.

Announcement of Results

The announcement of results shall be made the same day in the Valedictory function.

The Certificate of Participation shall be given to all the participants appearing for the quiz. The participants who will not be available for the Valedictory won’t be entitled to claim their certificate/prizes at a later stage.

Rules for Quiz Competition

Eligibility

Any Under-Graduate Law student (3years LL.B., 5years LL.B.) from any recognised University/ Institute shall be eligible to participate.

There is no limit of minimum or maximum number of Participation.

Language

The competition shall be conducted in both English & Hindi medium.

Registration Formalities

Each participant must register with the Organizing committee of National Quiz Competition (Written) based on MCQ, by sending the duly attested registration form along with the Demand Draft of Rs. 200/- in favour of Modern College of Law Payable at Ghaziabad. In case if there is more than one participation concerned College / University can send a single demand draft of all the participants but there registration form should be separately filled.

Guidelines for the Quiz Competition

The National Quiz Competition (Written) based on MCQ shall have 100 questions (Duration 2 hours), out of which 25% will be concerned with General Affairs regarding Women Law, 25% will be concerned with Current Affairs regarding Women Law and remaining 50% will be concerned with Legislative Acts regarding Women Law.

Syllabus

The students may be tested in respect of provisions of the Constitution and laws relating to women's rights and empowerment. The competition may, include topics relating to the following laws:

- (i) Constitution of India mainly, the Preamble, Fundamental Rights, Directive Principles of State Policy, Fundamental Duties, including Article 33 and Article 226 thereof.
- (ii) National Commission for Women Act, 1990 (20 of 1990)
- (iii) Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961
- (iv) Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005
- (v) The Sexual Harassment of Women at Work place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act) Act, 2013
- (vi) The Criminal Law Amendment Act, 2013
- (vii) The Maternity Benefit Act, 1961

- (viii) The Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 (34 of 1971)
- (ix) The Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956
- (x) The Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 1994
- (xi) The Minimum Wages Act, 1948
- (xii) SC and the ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015
- (xiii) The Scheduled Tribes and other traditional forest dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2008

Interpretation of Rules

- (a) The organizing committee's decision regards the interpretation of rules or any other matter related to the competition will be final.
- (b) If there is any situation, which is not contemplated in the rules, the organizing committee's decision on the same shall be final.
- (c) The organizers reserve the right to vary, alter, modify, or repeal any of the above rules if so required and as they deem appropriate.

Disputes

- (a) The participants seeking participation or participating in the competition shall honor and respect the spirit of the competition and endeavor to conduct by himself accordingly.
- (b) In case of any dispute or difficulty arising out of or during the course of the competition, the organizing committee shall have the sole and absolute authority to remove such difficulty and resolve the dispute.

Force Majeure

The organizers reserve the absolute right to cancel, defer or postpone indefinitely, the competition in the event of the accruing of any such incident, natural or man caused.

Dress Code

- a) All the participants are required to wear formals and carry their college ID Card.
