Candidates will be permitted to participate in this event along with three other events, but on payment of Additional Registration fee of Rs. 250 per participant.

Eligibility:

1. Students of both 3 year and 5 year LL.B Courses may participate in the following events.

- Legal Essay Writing Competition
- Extempore
- Comment a Judgment
- Judgment Writing
- JAM (Just A Minute)
- Spot Photography
- Law Quiz
- Criminal Investigation
- Street Play (English)
- Street Play (Malayalam) – Special Event

2. Students of B.B.A.LL.B, B.Com LL.B and students who pursue Management Courses (B.B.A, B.Com, M.B.A.) may participate in the following events.

- Business Quiz
- HR Game
- Marketing Game

3. Registered participants can participate only in three events of their choice (both individual and team events as well as the special event). However, they can participate in the special event as fourth event also but on payment of Registration fee of Rs. 250.

4. Special prize for **“Lord of the Rings” : Best Performer** will be given to the participant who scores maximum points by participating in any of the three events of the Vier (both law and management). However, in due course, if any “special

events of competition” are included, participation in those events will not be considered for selection of the Best Performer.

Ist prize : 5 points

IIInd prize : 3 points

IIIrd prize : 1points

Registration Details:

1) A Candidate who wishes to participate in the competition shall send the soft copy of the duly filled in Registration form along with the scanned copy of the D.D. for Rs.500/- per participant (Registration fee) to cblglcthrissur@gmail.com on or before 28.11.2017. 2) On-spot registration will also be permitted, but only on satisfaction of the following conditions.

- a) Participants must bring duly filled in Registration forms and the original D.D. for Rs. 500/- (Registration Fee)
- b) Candidates availing spot-registration will be allowed to participate only in one event per day
- c) Accommodation facility will not be provided to participants registered on-spot and they have to arrange accommodation of their own.

N.B: Participation will be confirmed only upon receipt of original D.D. for registration fee. However, registration fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

Accommodation:

Reasonable accommodation will be provided to already registered participants only on payment of **Rs. 1000/- per participant.**

Other Rules and Requirements:

- 1) The participants have to report in the college at 9 am itself and are requested to ensure that they complete the registration process before the start of the inaugural function.
- 2) Participants are not allowed to alter their registration on any cause.
- 3) The participants are advised to keep photocopies of all forms submitted to the Organizing Committee for their own purposes.
- 4) All participants shall carry their College ID Cards at the time of arrival as well as at all times thereafter, during the competition.
- 5) Participants shall ensure that their names are correctly spelt. The certificates shall bear the name with the spelling mentioned in the Registration Form.
- 6) Participants shall strictly wear the ID Cards issued to them at all times.
- 7) All participants must be dressed in a dignified manner (formal wear).
- 8) Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited during the events.
- 9) The participants may seek clarifications, if any, on or before commencement of the Competition.
- 10) Participants shall not reveal the identity including that of his/her college or university at any point of time during the competition.
- 11) The participants shall strictly follow the timings of each event, failing which the participants will be disqualified.
- 12) The participants are requested to check the schedule of events to be intimated after registration and shall plan their participation accordingly. The schedule of

events will be prepared with every caution. However, the organizers will not be responsible for clash of any events.

13) Friendly and healthy interaction among the participating teams and with the students of the host college is encouraged and expected.

14) The Organizing Committee Reserves all rights in the conduct of this programme. In case of any disputes, the decision of the organizing committee shall be final.

15) Time schedule of the whole competition will be made available after completion of online registration

16) It shall be assumed that the participants have read the entire Rules and Regulations and will have to act accordingly all throughout the programme.

A. “THE VERDICT” : THE ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

1. This event is an individual one and no team work will be allowed.
2. The participant should write the Essay in English on a topic given on the spot.
3. The time limit for the competition shall be one hour and the essay shall be of around 1500 words.
4. Decision of the judging panel shall be final and binding.

B. “NIGHT CRAWLER” : THE EXTEMPORE COMPETITION

1. This event is an individual one and no team work will be allowed.
2. Each participant shall be given five minutes to speak on the topic given by the judging panel. The topics will be based on contemporary social and legal issues.
3. A bell will ring at the end of four minutes to signify that one-minute is left to conclude his/her talk.
4. Another bell will ring at the end of five minutes.
5. The medium of the competition shall be English.
6. Decision of the judging panel shall be final and binding.

C. “DEATH NOTE” : THE JUDGMENT WRITING COMPETITION

1. This event is an individual one and no team work will be allowed.
2. There shall be an on spot judgment writing competition.
3. A problem shall be given 90 minutes before the competition.
4. The medium of the competition shall be English.
5. The participants shall complete writing of the judgment within 90 minutes and the judgment shall be of around 2000 words.
6. The participant shall maintain brevity, simplicity and clarity throughout in the judgment.
7. The Judgment shall be in the usual format of judgments of courts.
8. The Judgment shall consists of the following :

- (i) Introduction section:
- (ii) Setting out of the facts:
- (iii) The law and the issues:
- (iv) Applying the law to the facts:
- (v) Determining the relief; including costs;
- (vi) Finally, the order of the Court.

9. More details of the competition will be provided at the time of on-spot registration.

D. “JUDGMENT DAY” – THE COMMENT ON A JUDGMENT COMPETITION

1. This event is an individual one and no team work will be allowed.
2. The medium of the competition shall be English.
3. Participants have to comment on a recent judgment selected by the judging panel on the spot. The judgment selected may be from Constitutional law, Criminal law or Environmental law.
4. Participants will be given 90 minutes time for reference and they may avail internet facility of their own for the purpose of reference.
5. Participants are expected to analyze the judgment and express their own perceptions on the judgment in a critical way.
6. The time allotted for preliminary round is 15 – 20 minutes and for the final round is 20 – 25 minutes.
7. The participant shall include in his comment the following:
 - (a) Facts
 - (b) Opinion (both assenting and descending, if any,) by the judge/judges
 - (c) Judgment of the court.
 - (d) Its critical analysis.
 - (e) Opinion or comment on that judgment.

8. Decision by the judging panel will be final and binding

1. This event is an individual one and no team work will be allowed.
2. The medium of the competition shall be English.
3. Participants shall speak for just a minute on a given topic subject to the terms and conditions as set by the moderator.
4. Moderator’s decision will be final and binding.

1. This event is an individual one and no team work will be allowed.
2. The participants must bring their own digital Camera/ DSLR’s to make their click.
3. Photography using Mobile phones will not be allowed.
4. Carry your own USB Cable/Memory Card Reader.
5. Theme shall be unveiled on the spot and based on that each participant has to submit their clicks within the allotted time.

6. Individual participation only, no restrictions as to the number of students from each college.
7. There will be three rounds: Preliminary, Semi-final and Final (subject to change according to the number of participants).
8. Participants are requested to be on time along with your ID cards.
9. Decision of the Judging panel shall be final and binding.

1. This is a team event and each team shall consist of two participants only. No cross teams will be entertained.
2. Replacement of any participant of the team after registration is not allowed.
3. The medium of the competition shall be English.
4. There may be written preliminary rounds.
5. The Quiz will cover topics pertaining to current affairs, legal subjects and contemporary legal issues and concerns.
6. The use of mobile phones or any electronic gadgets in between the quiz will lead to disqualification.
7. The decision of the Quiz Master will be final and binding.

H. “USUAL SUSPECTS” : THE CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION COMPETITION

1. It is a Crime Scene Investigation.
2. This is a team event and each team shall consist of three participants only. No cross teams will be entertained.
3. The medium of the competition shall be English.
4. The teams have to examine a Crime scene model closely, and prepare two reports. One being the First Information Report (FIR) and the second being the General Investigation Report (charge sheet) would identify the accused.
5. Each team will be provided a time of 10 minutes to examine the Crime Scene & to take note of the evidences. After examining the scene, 20 minutes time will be provided to submit the reports in written form.
6. Finally, the Reports have to be justified before the judging panel by any one member, with clear reasons justifying as to why such stance has been taken. Time for Justification will be 10 minutes.
7. The Decision of the Judging panel will be final & binding.

1. This is a team event and each team shall consist of minimum 6 and maximum 10 members. No cross teams will be entertained.
2. The medium of the competition shall be English.
3. Topics for the Street Play

Preliminary Round: Social Media & Indian Youth.

Final Round: Changing Scenario of Indian Women.

3. Time for the Street Play shall be 10 -15 minutes.
4. Teams must bring all their requirements for the street play. Properties or costume or any other material will not be provided by the hosting college.
5. Use of abusive language and indecent behavior /indecent dressing will lead to disqualification.

6. Medium of the competition shall be English.
7. Top 4 teams will be selected to the Final Round.
8. Decision by the judging panel will be final and binding.
