## **“प्रश्नोTRY”**

This Semester, Legal Support Service Committee, School of Law, G.D. Goenka University is organizing its "FIRST NATIONAL QUIZ COMPETITION - प्रश्नोTRY" on February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2018 (Wednesday). The broad theme for the said competition is 'Constitutional Law, Legal General Awareness and Legal History'. It is unique among the existing genesis of quiz across the country. It provides a platform to the young achievers in legal field that profound judiciary, and other competitive exams as their dreams.

प्रश्नोTRY is a stepping stone to find out the existing knowledge which is important to excel in the legal education. The said event is expected to have participation from about 25 Law Schools and Universities from across India.

### **Attributes of the प्रश्नोTRY**

The 'First National Quiz Competition on Constitutional Law' will be organized on February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2018 from 09: 00 a.m. – 04:30 p.m.

### **Syllabi of the प्रश्नोTRY**

The syllabi of प्रश्नोTRY will be covered from:

- The Constitution of India;
- Current Affairs related to the Constitutional provision;
- Recent case law inclusive of landmark judgements; and
- the constitutional debates prior to the year 1950 only.

### **Eligibility of the प्रश्नोTRY Participants**

Students from both three year and five year law course/s from a recognized university/institute shall be eligible to participate. Both the participants should be enrolled in same university/institute.

Participants are required to carry valid College ID Cards on the day of competition. They have to submit hard copies of the registration form at the registration desk while reporting to the GDGU प्रश्नोTRY team.

### **Dress Code**

All the participants are required to wear professional formals as prescribed in the Advocates Act, 1961.

### **Guiding Principles for प्रश्नोTRY**

1. Each team shall consist of 2 Members. A single individual coming up will not be allowed to participate.
2. There is no bar on multiple teams from a single institution.
3. There will be four rounds to be conducted under the aegis of प्रश्नोTRY. The format of 'objective questions' will be consisting of multiple choice questions, true-false, and assertion-reasoning. The details of the said rounds are as follows:
  - a. Round I – Written Quiz with objective questions
  - b. Round II – Oral Quiz with objective questions
  - c. Round III - Rapid Fire
  - d. Round IV – Buzzer

- e. In a case of tie among teams at any level, a mini rapid fire round will be conducted to break such tie.

4. All rounds will be knock out rounds.

5. In selected round/s negative marking will exist, which will be informed on the spot.

### **Results**

The announcement of results shall be made after each subsequent rounds.

The 'Certificate of Participation' shall be given to all the participants for the quiz only at the Valedictory function. In case of no show during valedictory function, participants would not be entitled to claim their certificate/prizes at any later stage.

### **Dispute Resolution Committee**

- The participants seeking participation or participating in the competition shall honour and respect spirit of the competition and endeavour top conduct by themselves accordingly.
- In case of any dispute or difficulty arising out of or during the course of the competition, the organizing committee shall have the sole and absolute authority to remove such difficulty and resolve the dispute through its Dispute Resolution Committee (hereinafter, DRC).
- A panel of DRC members will be sitting in every round for the purpose of smooth functioning and avoiding any conflict.

### **Interpretation of Rules for प्रश्नोत्तरी**

- The organizing committee's decision regarding the interpretation of rules or its relating matter will be final.
- Occurrence of any situation which is not contemplated in the rules will be forward to the DRC. The decision of the said DRC will be final and binding.

### **Force Majeure**

- The organizers reserve the absolute right to cancel, defer or postpone indefinitely, the competition in the event of the occurrence of any such incident, natural or man caused.
- The organizers reserve the right to vary, alter, modify, or repeal any of the प्रश्नोत्तरी rules, if so required, as they deem fit.

### **Accolades with प्रश्नोत्तरी**

There will be attractive prizes as:

- Sponsored books for first three teams;
- Sponsored Cash Prizes for first three teams;
- Trophies for Winner;
- 'Certificate of Participation' will be awarded to all participating teams.

### **How to Register?**

Each participant must register by sending the duly attested e-registration form along with the RTGS/NEFT Details. The hard copies of the same must be submitted on the day of competition. Registration fee is INR 500/- (without Accommodation) and INR 1500/- (including Accommodation) for each team respectively. Accommodation shall be provided to students coming from outside Delhi-NCR only.
