## Introduction

The European Union is a unique entity exemplifying functionalism and neo-functionalism. The process of European integration displayed a very significant and interesting blend of Inter-governmental and Supra Nationalism. The EU's development has transformed governance in Europe. EU law is a dynamic and continuously expanding area of law, which has had an impact on varied areas of legal practice.

In addition to substantive rules emerging out of national, shared and exclusive competencies, the EU law imposes procedural obligations on national courts, state bodies and administrative authorities to ensure its effective implementation. It further provides mechanisms by which individuals and entities may seek redress for breaches of EU laws. The Lisbon Treaty and The EU's Charter of Fundamental Rights guarantee a wide-ranging set of rights, freedoms and principles and enumerates primary legal norms on the basis of which secondary EU legislation and national implementing measures may be interpreted and assessed. The EU Laws have made far-reaching strides in the area of Human Rights Law, Competition Law, IP Law regime, Environmental Law, and Cyber Security. This provides a challenging and unique setting to the study of European integration and the subsequent processes of laws and governance emerging out of it.
