About

Therefore, to explain the importance of forensic science and medical jurisprudence in criminal investigation the School of Law, Manipal University Jaipur is organizing a Seminar on 3rd and 4th November, 2018.

Theme

The main theme of the Seminar is “**Role of Forensic Science and Medical Jurisprudence in Criminal Investigation**”.

4. Mobile Device Forensic
5. Cyber Security
6. Forensic Investigation
7. Forensic Medicine
8. Crime Scene Investigation

The above areas of Crime Investigation and sub-themes are indicative in nature. The participants are free to choose an inter-disciplinary topic involving one or more of the above areas of law or sub-themes, provided that it fits within the broad theme of the Seminar.

Communication

All communication should be via e-mail/online only. (No hard copies required to be posted)

Guidelines for Paper Presentation

- The Seminar shall have paper presentations (including articles, notes and comments) that shall be selected after a blind review procedure to be conducted by the Editorial Board.
- The presenters will present their papers before a panel of experts who shall adjudge the paper presentations.
- The participants may adopt any suitable means for presenting the papers including audio-visual aids, Power Point presentations etc.
- In case of co-authorship at least one author must present the paper
- The University will provide accommodation to all the authors who are selected to present their papers at the seminar.

Rewards

- Three best research papers will stand a chance of getting them published.
- The three best presenters will also be awarded cash prizes.

Note: We will publish the abstracts of papers shortlisted for presentation in a seminar proceeding. We are also planning to publish selected papers as an edited book.

Submission Guidelines

Please note that the submissions must conform to the following requirements:

1. Authors are requested to send a soft copy of their manuscripts .doc or .docx format to sony.kulshrestha@jaipur.manipal.edu with the subject as "Submission- [Name of Author] – Submission for Seminar."
2. The acceptable length of Articles is between 5000-8000 words, and of Notes and Comments between 3000-5000 words, including footnotes.
3. All submissions must include an abstract of not more than 300 words, explaining the main idea, objective of the article and the conclusions drawn from it.
4. The Article should be in Time New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line Spacing and 1 inch margins on each side. Footnotes should be in font size 10 and with single line spacing.
5. The Authors should conform to the Harvard Bluebook (20th edition) system of citation. The relevant sources should be duly acknowledged as footnotes.
6. Authors should provide their contact details, designation and institutional affiliation only in the covering letter for the submission. The authors are to refrain from mentioning their details in the manuscript itself considering the evaluation of the submission is subject to a blind review. Each submission may have up to two authors.
7. The submission must be the original work of the authors. Any form of plagiarism will lead to direct rejection.
8. Authors of the shortlisted submissions will be intimated regarding the review process.
9. The decision of the Editorial Board in this regard shall be final.

The university/organizers will not be liable for the consequences of any unpredictable event that might disrupt the seminar
