## General Rules and Regulations

- ♣ The registration fee per person shall be Rs. 300/-
- ♣ According to the time schedule one student will not be able to participate in more than one item.
- ♣ Participation in Legal debate and Judgment analysis is restricted to Law students.
- ♣ Participation in Best Corporate Advisor is restricted to UG Students. Any UG/PG students can participate in all other items.
- ♣ Only consolation prizes will be awarded if the number of teams registering for the event is less than four.
- ♣ A college can send one team for each event.
- ♣ There shall be an Overall trophy and a Runner up trophy for colleges getting highest points. Points shall be allotted according to the following table:

- ♣ Participants are required to report at 9.00 AM on 22nd February, at Bharata Mata School of Legal Studies Campus.
- ♣ Participation Certificate will be issued to all the participants.
- ♣ Participants should carry their college ID card and letter of authorization from their college Principal/Director.
- ♣ Participants from outside Kerala requiring accommodation should make a prior intimation.
- ♣ Participants are required to maintain discipline in the college premises.
- ♣ The decision of the Organizing Committee shall be binding.

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## Rules for Competition Events

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### BSOLUIZ- QUIZ

- ♣ All UG/PG Students can participate.
- ♣ Questions will be from General Law, General Knowledge and Current Affairs.
- ♣ There shall be an elimination round before the main rounds.
- ♣ A team shall consist of two (2) members, and the participation is restricted to one team from a college.
- ♣ Language of the quiz shall be English.
- ♣ The participants are prohibited from using any form of electronic gadgets, including mobile phones during the competition.
- ♣ The decision of the QUIZ MASTER shall be final and binding for all matters relating to competition.

### SIZZLE N' STOMP- Theme Dance

- ♣ All UG/PG Students can participate.
- ♣ Theme of the dance should be based on **Social Justice**
- ♣ Each performance should not exceed Seven minutes.
- ♣ Each Team may have six to eight members. All team members must be from same college.
- ♣ The songs should not have lyrics.

- ♣ Participants required to bring USB/ CD and audio track will be in MP3 format. The USB/CD should handover to the organising committee at the reporting time.
- ♣ No props will be provided here. Participants can carry their own props.
- ♣ Dance performance should not convey any indecent gestures.
- ♣ Decision of Judges shall be final and binding.

## VIA THEATRUM-STREET PLAY

- ♣ All UG/PG Students can participate.
- ♣ The theme of the play should be based on **Social Justice**.
- ♣ The language will be Malayalam/English.
- ♣ Team should restrict their play to 15 minutes
- ♣ A team should consist of six to eight members.
- ♣ There will be a gap of five minutes between the presentation of each team.
- ♣ The competition will be conducted in an open place.
- ♣ Any kind of electronic gadgets are strictly restricted.
- ♣ Participants can sing or dance by themselves or use indigenous percussion to create necessary music.
- ♣ Teams must bring all requirements and must be ready on time.
- ♣ Costume or the like will not be provided by the host college. Costumes or any actions that are inappropriate or offensive are strictly prohibited.
- ♣ The decision of the judges will be final.

## **CORPORATE CONSUASOR -BEST CORPORATE ADVISOR**

- ♣ All UG Students can participate.
- ♣ The competition shall be in English.
- ♣ A college shall be represented by one (1) team consisting of two (2) members.
- ♣ The participants are prohibited from using any form of electronic gadgets, including mobile phones during the competition.
- ♣ The decision of the judges shall be final. The organizers reserve the right to change the rules of the event, including the rounds as may be necessary and their decisions shall be binding.
- ♣ Rounds will be conducted according to the following pattern.

### **I. Written Round**

- (a) A maximum of 20 minutes will be given to each team to complete the written aptitude test.
- (b) Teams that qualify this round shall be eligible to participate in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> round.

### **II. Entrepreneurial Venture Round**

- (a) The objective of this round is to test the participant's skills at advising on how to start a business.
- (b) Participants will be informed in advance the areas in which they will have to offer entrepreneurial advice. On the day of competition, candidates will have to select the sector on which they have to advice the client who comes before them, through lot system.
- (c) They will get a maximum of 15 minutes to present their advice for the business based on the questions put to them.
- (d) Judges also may pose questions to the candidates.

### **III. Policy Review Round**

- (a) Participants will be given a Government regulation/policy and asked to review it.
- (b) Each team will be given 15 minutes for preparation and three (3) minutes to present the written draft of the review.
- (c) Teams that qualify the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> round shall be eligible to participate in the 4<sup>th</sup> round.

### **IV. Stress Round**

#### **Round 1 - *Ashwamedham***

- (a) Participants should come prepared on the life history of eminent industrialists/entrepreneurs/CEOs and the like.
- (b) During the round, each team will have to identify the personality allotted for them through a process of asking a limited number of closed questions.
- (c) Each team will be allowed to guess the right answer within a given period.

#### **Round 2 – *The Tempest***

- (d) In this round, the team will engage in multi stakeholder negotiation on behalf of a corporate client, where representatives of trade unions, public activists, representatives of the government will be present. Participants will be expected to successfully negotiate a dispute between these various stakeholders within a given time period.
- (e) Participant's knowledge of business cases studies and their skills in mediation will be among the criteria.

## ***JUDICIUM ANALYSIS* - JUDGMENT ANALYSIS**

- ♣ Participation is restricted to Law students
- ♣ The language of the competition shall be English.
- ♣ A team shall consist of two (2) members, and the participation is restricted to one (1) teams from a college.

- ♣ Both members of the team should speak.
- ♣ Participants will be provided with all the judgments 10 days before the competition for their preparation.
- ♣ Participants will be allocated one (1) judgment for analysis based on the drawing of lots. Thereafter they will be allowed one hour to prepare for the presentation.
- ♣ Priority of the presentation shall be decided on the basis of lots.
- ♣ For drawing of the lots participants should be present at 9 AM on the date of event.
- ♣ The team will be allotted 20 minutes for presentation.
- ♣ The team may also have to face questions from judges.
- ♣ Content, clarity, fluency and style of presentation shall be among the criteria adopted by the judges for awarding marks.
- ♣ Participants should prepare a power point presentation to present their analysis.

### ***LEGITIMUM DISPUTATIO***- LEGAL DEBATE

- ♣ Participation is restricted to Law students
- ♣ The language for the Debate will be English.
- ♣ Each team must consist of two members.
- ♣ The competition will be in three rounds.
- ♣ The topic for the first round shall be “Will economic reservation for forward classes pass judicial scrutiny?”. This topic shall be common for all participating teams.
- ♣ The topic for the other two rounds will be given only ten minutes prior to each team according to their turns at presentation.
- ♣ The order of presentation shall be decided by the system of lot.

- ♣ Teams will be judged on criteria that may include- content, clarity, style, delivery, structure, timing, understanding of issues, diction etc.
- ♣ The decision of judges is final
- ♣ The organisers hold the right to revise the above rules at any time.
- ♣ The participants are prohibited from using any form of electronic gadgets, including mobile phones during the competition.
- ♣ Rounds will be conducted according to the following pattern

### **Round One**

One person from each team shall speak for the subject and the other person shall speak against the subject. Each team shall be given a total of six minutes.

### **Round Two**

Six best teams from round one will be selected to participate in round two. Each college team will be paired up with another college team by system of lot. Thus round two will have three groups. In each group college A will compete with college B. Each team will have one Affirmative speaker and a Negative speaker. College A Affirmative Speaker shall present his or her points followed by the rebuttal of college B Negative speaker and further clarification from the Affirmative speaker. Later college B Affirmative speaker will speak followed by the rebuttal of college A Negative speaker and further clarification. Time shall be given for the judges to clarify points. A total of twenty minutes for each group. The same procedure follows for group two and three.

### **Round Three**

The best two teams shall be selected to round three. The topic shall be given ten Minutes prior to the round. Out of the two teams one shall be team Affirmative and team Negative by the process of lots. Proper debate is conducted. Judges may clarify points.
