TRAINING-CUM-INTERNSHIP PROCEDURE & GUIDELINES ARE GIVEN BELOW –

Programme Design for Internship/Training of Three Weeks Duration

Talks/ Interactive Meetings/ Discussions with Experts on Legal issues will be held on –

1. Know Your Fundamental Rights.
2. An independent, efficient and cost-effective legal aid service.
3. Legal Consciousness.
4. Grievance Redressal Forums.
5. Formation of laws & policies.
6. Know the Power of Right to Information etc.
7. Improving the quality and accessibility of legal aid services to the public.
8. Need for inclusiveness of the Transgender people.
9. Legal Literacy and Awareness Camps.
10. Institutionalizing the Alternate Dispute Resolution methods.
11. Creating base for para-legal volunteers.
12. Broad based activities, in co-ordination with Governmental and non-Governmental agencies, Universities and others, promoting the cause of legal services to the poor.

A minimum of 3 interactive sessions will be held during this Training-cum-Internship. Information material along with assignments will be emailed to all participants every week.

In addition to above, Interns/ Trainees would be expected to take up some individual as well as group activities and voluntary assignments given by us and raise awareness regarding concerns and activities of our NGO as per guidelines provided from time to time.

On completion of Training-cum-Internship, every intern is expected to submit Completion and Evaluation Report in prescribed format.

Groups will be formed, consisting of 3-4 interns/ trainees in each group and each group will be assigned a project/study to be completed during the period of internship/ training. The subject of this project/study would be decided in consultation with the group and will be commensurate with the age, education and area of interest of the interns/ trainees in that group.

The progress of the assignment is monitored on weekly basis. The students residing in NCR are expected to visit the office of Vyomchaya at least once a week. Outstation candidates may be permitted to pursue their training with the help of on-line assistance provided by mentors.

After completion of assignment, the trainees/ interns will submit a Study/Project Report, duly approved by Mentor. He/she will also submit Completion and Evaluation Report in prescribed format.

Learning Outcomes and Goals

At the end of the Training, you will –

- ✓ Become an enlightened scholar, familiar with legal provisions relating to abovementioned matters.
- ✓ Have social outreach in almost every governmental organizations.
- ✓ Address various public meetings and client counseling sessions under the supervision of our mentors.
- ✓ Be able to guide the eligible litigants to avail free legal aid services of the State.
- ✓ Can use the potential of internet to benefit the legal aid movement avoiding any alien organizations who may misuse your genuine cause of action.
- ✓ Be able to serve the society by helping others by informing them about legal aid services & fulfilling our social responsibility.
- ✓ Get high potential and a wide range of positive effects that legal aid can provide for marginalized communities. Thus you will be able to gather more information for research, hence much can be learned and encouraged through our programme.
- ✓ Trainees enrolled for Training-cum-Internship of over three weeks duration will also gain knowledge and practical experience of doing research work under guidance of mentors

and also an opportunity to interact with the legal luminaries viz. eminent judges, lawyers and jurists.

- ✓ We pair students with mentors who are staff advocates on record, who can provide participating student interns/ trainees with support during their training at Legal Aid and in the recruitment process.
- ✓ This legal aid will be expanded in the future and make more positive change in society.

Guidelines for Training-cum-Internship at Vyomchhaya

1. Students pursuing undergraduate or graduate programme in Law, Social Science or Humanities (Law preferred) from any recognized institution in India, having interest in legal awareness issues, are eligible for training-cum-internship.
2. Interested candidates are required to mail their CV to vyomchhaya4intern@gmail.com.
3. We believe in making future lawyers more equipped in terms of the practical legal skills and therefore if you have that inner instinct to learn, you are welcome. Decision of Vyomchhaya will be final with regard to the intake of interns.
4. Internship Locations are- New Delhi/Noida/Greater Noida.
5. Interns are required to send the filled form (Form will be intimated by the our Selection Committee after the thorough selection of interns/ trainees) along with a nominal fee required to provide a setup for training and internship.

NOTE – Deposition of fee to be made only after selection. Payment methods are subject to the organization requirements that may be changed for last minute transactions. Trainees' convenience will be of utmost priority during the process.

6. No stipend is paid to trainees/ interns by Vyomchhaya. Similarly no reimbursement of expenditure incurred on travel etc is made by us.
7. We are not responsible for any arrangements for stay etc for outstation candidates.
8. Induction Programme of half day duration will be organized at the start of the Training-cum-Internship Batch. It is mandatory to participate in the induction programme for all trainees.
9. Participants from NCR would be expected to participate in all meetings/sessions. They will generally be held in the afternoons of Saturday/ Sunday or holidays.

10. After the induction process is over, outstation trainees/ interns may be permitted, on request, to pursue this internship with the help of on-line guidance.
11. Intellectual inputs and guidelines to facilitate successful completion of this programme will be provided by experts in Vyomchhaya.
12. Progress of given assignments would be monitored on weekly basis.
13. Trainees/ Interns would also be expected to take up some voluntary assignments given by Vyomchhaya and raise awareness regarding concerns and activities of Vyomchhaya as per guidelines provided from time to time.
14. After evaluation by experts of Vyomchhaya, the major findings emanating from studies carried out by trainees/ interns may be disseminated through social media for the benefit of large number of people. They may also be used for Advocacy Campaigns by Vyomchhaya. Full credit is generally given to the contribution made by trainees or interns.
