Lloyd Law College, Greater Noida, U.P., India was established 2003 in affiliation with CCS University, Meerut, U.P. (state university established in 1965) and approved by the Bar Council of India (patron of professional legal education in India). We are imparting regular professional degree in the mode of BA.LL.B. - 5 year and LL.B. - 3 year program. During the last sixteen years in BA.LL.B. - 5 year program eleven batches consisted of 1500 approx. students and in LL.B. - 3 year program thirteen batches consisted of 2200 approx. students successfully completed degree from this college and entered Bar, Bench, Law firms and national and multi-national corporations. Currently 2000 approx. students are taught and trained by 75 approx. faculty members from regular academics, visiting practitioners and professionals. The minimum attendance percentage for students in the campus is 75% and pass percentage is 95%.
