Guidelines for Submission:

- The essay must be written in English only.
- Word limit – 1200-2000 words. Significantly longer essays will not be considered.
- The essay should be typed in Times New Roman, font size 12 and line spacing 1.5.
- The footnoting should be done in Times New Roman, font size 10 and line spacing 1.0.
- Essay must be original and unpublished as any form of plagiarism will result in disqualification of essay.
- Essay **must be** in MS-Word document format.
- In addition to sending the essay as an attachment, you must include your name, mailing address, and the university or school that you're enrolled in.
- All submission of essays shall be made in soft copies to **lexlawgical.adm@gmail.com** and subject of the mail should be "First essay writing competition".
