

Theme of the seminar

The Air & Space Law sector is poised for many changes. The aviation zone has profound changes resulting in open skies policy, privatization of airports and airlines. Satellite Services, Space Exploration, Navigation and Research related sectors indirectly cater to all services around the world has undergone infinite growth. India through ISRO (Indian Space Research Organization) is involved in space exploration ventures, like Aditya L1 mission to planet Sun in 2019-20 and Mars Orbiter Mission-2 in 2022-23. Civil Aviation and space industry has witnessed an unprecedented growth in recent years with private commercial activities.

According to ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization) study global aviation has grown almost 20 percent in 2018. India has keen interest to develop new air routes to Middle East, Africa and Latin American countries. North east part of India is being linked to countries in South East Asia to improve national tourism and economy. Air law is the set of national and international rules concerning aircraft, air navigation, aero commercial transport and all relations public or private, arising from domestic and international air navigation.

Space Law is meant to regulate relations between states to determine their rights and duties resulting from all activities directed towards outer space which is equally important for the world society. Space exploration has produced a revolution through education, communication and remote sensing satellites. In the 21st century we may have combined regime of aerospace law. The ever-increasing number of private aers operating in the space industry has given rise to the concern for adequate domestic legal frameworks to regulate commercial space activities, and India is no exception. Hence, a comprehensive review of expanding horizons of air and space law is the need of an hour.

With initiation of Air and Space tourism, now the time has come where legal professionals need to define a boundary between Air Laws and Outer Space Laws. The role of lawyers

in this area is very essential in order to face imminent and important legal challenges which will arise with the development of technology.
