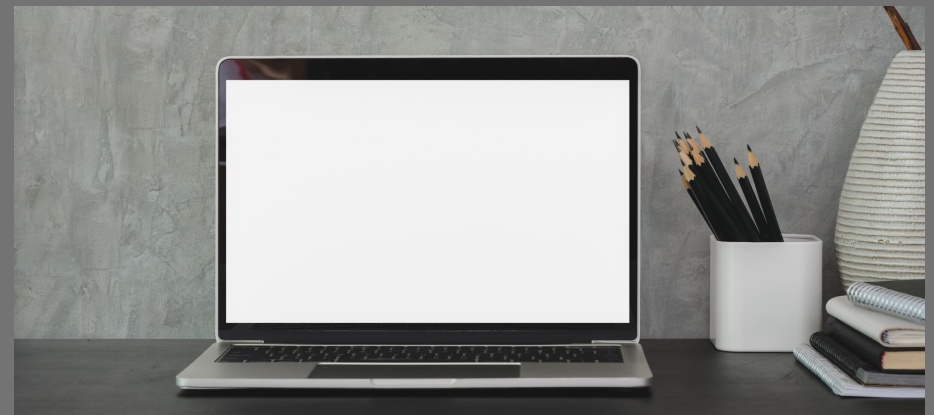

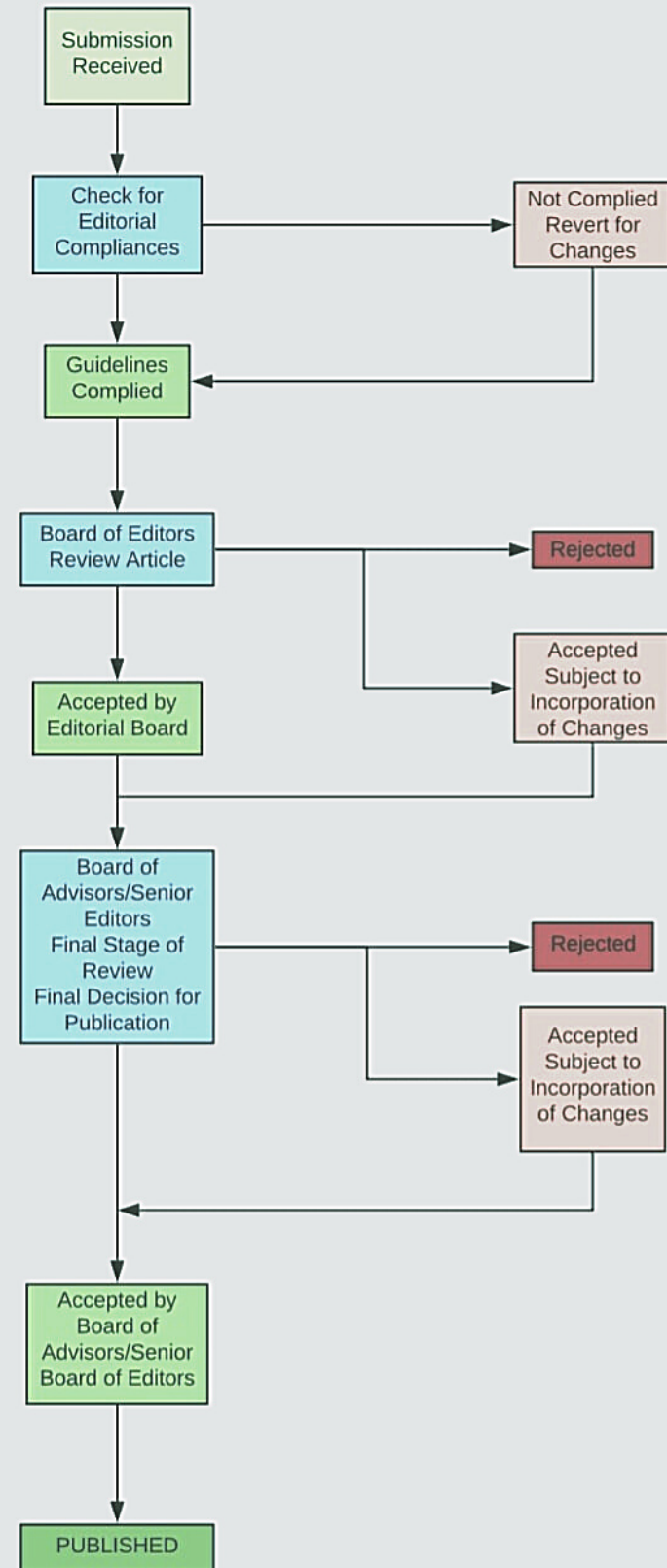


THREE STAGED REVIEW PROCESS

Thereafter, the submission will be finally reviewed by our Board of Advisors in the third Stage. Articles can be sent back to the author at any stage for incorporating suggested changes / complying with submission guidelines.

The decision by the Editorial Board or the Board of Advisors (as the case may be) regarding acceptance or rejection of the Article will be final and binding.
